



ORGANIZATIONAL LEVELS OF SMOKING AWARENESS



01

- Programs that do not address smoking

05

- Completion of Level 4**
- Programs that do not address smoking
- Persons served are assessed regularly for motivation to address their smoking behavior.
- Tobacco harm reduction is included in treatment goals as directed by persons served (services may be provided off-site).

02

- A formal written policy describing smoking practices for staff and persons served.
- Smoking policies are included in the program's welcoming statement and there is onsite signage and resources available for persons served.
- The program has smoke-free entryways (minimum of 20 ft.).

06

- Completion of Level 5**
- Tobacco addiction is included in treatment goals as directed by persons served (some services may be provided off-site).
- Program provides onsite tobacco harm reduction services for persons served.

03

- Completion of Level 2**
- Designated smoking area(s) clearly identified, if applicable.

07

- Completion of Level 6**
- Program provides Safer Nicotine Products (SNP) and Nicotine Replacement Therapies (NRTs) or assists with access to SNPs, NRTs and/or other FDA-approved cessation medications.

04

- Completion of Level 3**
- Persons served are educated regularly about smoking and health.

08

- Completion of Level 7**
- Program has policies to allow staff and clients to utilize non-combustible harm reduction products (snus, e-cigarettes, heat-not-burn devices, etc.) onsite.
